Currently, the museum can provide a dating record service for Crossley, Tangye, Mirrlees and Gardner engines; even then we cannot guarantee that we have all the records but will provide what information we can from those available. We also have a limited amount of information on National engines. We currently do not provide a technical enquiry service.
